practices and dance classes, just roll on up and talk to us!

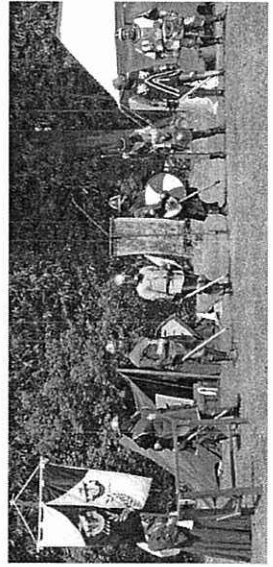

We welcome newcomers to our events. If you're keen on anything medieval, check us out.

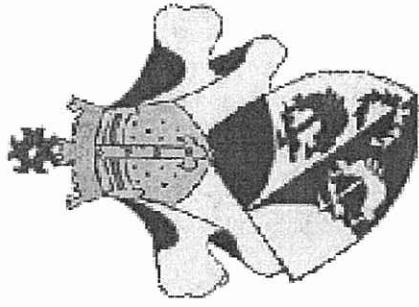

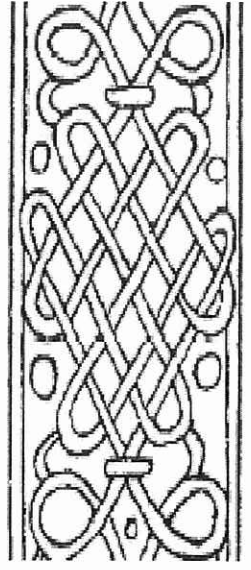
